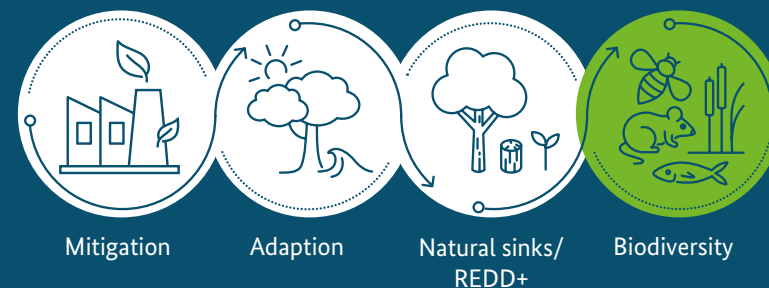

The International Climate Initiative (IKI) is the key instrument of the Federal Ministry for the Environment, Nature Conservation and Nuclear Safety (BMU) for international funding of climate protection and biodiversity. Through IKI, the BMU supports solution strategies in developing and emerging countries that seek to achieve sustainable change.

To date, over **300** biodiversity-relevant projects with a total volume of approximately **€1.3** billion have been supported.

Biodiversity conservation as a core funding component

Since 2011, the conservation of biological diversity features as a separate IKI funding area. It is, however, also a vital element in the other funding areas, leading to diverse projects contributing decisively to the conservation of biodiversity.

One funding programme – a range of topics

The IKI promotes a range of topics under this funding area. Some of them include; the expansion of protected areas, the restoration of forests and other ecosystems, the mobilisation of financial resources, biodiversity in cities and the concept of ecosystem-based adaptation to the impacts of climate change. The range of biodiversity-relevant priority topics is diverse. Wherever possible, climate protection and biodiversity conservation are interlinked at the IKI.

Participation as an important element

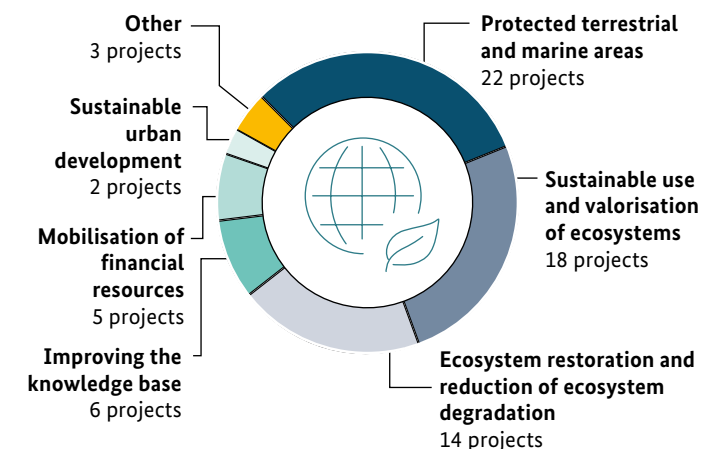
